Tips for Nominating Someone For An Award

- Review the criteria for the award and make sure the nominee fits the bill for that award.
- Get as much background information as is possible on your candidate – make sure to include information on the year and place of graduation, work experience, boards, councils, committees on which he/she has served, including non-pharmacy organizations.
- Get some testimonials from colleagues (other pharmacists but also other members of the team – doctors, nurses, technicians, etc.), clients and anyone else who can support your candidate with concrete evidence of excellence.
- Once you've got your information gathered write a letter of reference explaining how the accomplishments meet the award's criteria and stating why this person deserves an award.

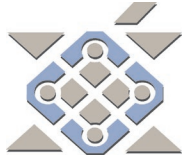
Nomination for an award must include the following:

- Completed nomination form signed by two active members
- Minimum two letters of reference
- CV or biography of nominee / or tell us in story format why this individual deserves this award
- Background documentation to support the award nomination

Deadline Date: **April 15** – If received late, this nomination will be forwarded for the following year. The Awards Committee accepts nominations all year round, we encourage everyone to participate in the Awards Nomination Process at any time during the year.
